# **Before the Exchange**

# **Necessary Documents:**

- 1. Student Application Form
- 2. Student Information Form
- 3. Learning Protocol (3 original copies signed and stamped)

Important Note: The documents are available on our website <a href="http://www.mevlana.hitit.edu.tr/mevlana-degisim-programi/belgeler/belgeler">http://www.mevlana.hitit.edu.tr/mevlana-degisim-programi/belgeler/belgeler</a> and should be filled out in computer environment, not by hand and sent to your International Relations Office.

- Learning Protocol must be prepared according to the course programs of the relevant departments.
- Learning Protocol must be confirmed and signed by the students' academic units and university.
- The confirmed and signed Learning Protocols must be sent to Hitit University Mevlana Exchange Program Coordinatorate by e-mail.
- The Learning Protocols will be confirmed by the relevant units in Hitit University and sent back to the student's university.
- Upon students' arrival at Hitit University, students are required to bring 3 original copies of their Learning Protocols to Hitit University.

- 4. Letter of Acceptance (Prepared by Hitit University)
- 5. Health Insurance: All students must arrange private Health Insurance before coming to Turkey and bring with them the insurance document with a Turkish translation. Before your arrival, please visit the website of Directorate General of Migration Management (<a href="http://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/">http://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/</a>) and read all the steps/necessary documents carefully. Host university is not responsible for the problems which may occur during your residence permission process.

# **During the Exchange**

## **Necessary Documents:**

- Residence Permit: With the educational visa(for the countries required), the students will apply for
  residence permit. Students should pay a one-time fee of around 60 TL(20 \$) for their residence permit.
  All the documents needed for residence permit have to be complete. Please visit the website of
  Directorate General of Migration Management ( <a href="http://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/">http://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/</a>) and read all the
  steps/necessary documents carefully.
- 2. Identification Number: In order to have TL account for their scholarship, students need to get an identification number from the tax office.
- 3. Turkish Lira Account: When the students get their residence permit, they need to open a bank account from Halkbank in order to get their scholarship.
- 4. Mevlana Student Scholarship Agreement: Students will receive this document showing the details about the scholarship with the signature from Mevlana Coordinatorship of Hitit University.
- 5. 12 passport size photos: (for your residence permit, course and dormitory registration process)

#### **ACCOMODATION**

#### **State Dormitory:**

When the student is accepted to participate in Mevlana Exchange Program, s/he will apply for the state dormitory which costs an affordable price from the website of General Directorate of Credit and Dormitories Agency(KYK) <a href="http://kyk.gsb.gov.tr/">http://kyk.gsb.gov.tr/</a>. The exact date for the application will be announced later, most probably in August. The acceptance of your stay is left to dormitory institution.

#### **Private Dormitory:**

If the student is not accepted to the state dormitory, we help them to find a rental shared room which costs around 600 TL(200\$) per month without food.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP**

#### Incoming Mevlana Exchange Program Student Scholarship: 825 TL (monthly)

80% of the scholarship is paid monthly (4 months) to the student. The remaining amount 20% is paid according to the duration of the mobility indicated in the Certificate of Attendance and the success of the student.

The credits are taken into consideration while paying the rest of the scholarship (the ratio between the total number of the credits of the courses completed, the number of the courses that the student is obliged to take and the total number of credits of all obligatory courses.

!!! Important Note: It will last almost one month for students to get their scholarships because of official procedures (getting residence permission, opening bank account). Therefore, students are required to come prepared economically for their expenses.

# **TRANSPORTATION**

#### First Arrive in Çorum!

Students are required to arrive in Çorum in the working days and hours in case they need help to find their dormitories and the university. You may contact to Inst. Esra AKDOĞAN with the phone number +90 364 219 19 91.

#### **Urban Transportation**

Public transportation vehicles in every 15 minutes from the main bus stop around Clock Tower in the city center enable trasportation to the North Campus of our university.

## **Intercity Transportation**

Intercity transportation with the bus is possible at all hours of the day and night in Çorum. Çorum is 243 km far from Ankara, 175 km far from Samsun and 614 km far from İstanbul.

#### **Air Transportation**

The nearest airport to Çorum is in Merzifon, Amasya. It takes around 30 min from the airport to our university by taxi or service bus. There are flights from Istanbul Atatürk Airport and Istanbul Sabiha Gökçen Airport to Merzifon Airport with Turkish Airlines and Pegasus Airlines.
